Apologies to your parents but this is a screen-based hunt. On the plus side it's really easy to do indoors and you can race your friends and relations wherever they are in the world. You might even find out something interesting as you go. Either save the webpages as evidence or write the answers down. I recommend you print out the list if possible so you can refer to it while you search.

You can play in one of these ways:

- Solo – time yourself to see how long you take to find them all.
- Solo – you have a set time limit, see how many of the items you can find in that time.
- 2 or more players – agree a time limit and see who can find the most items in the time

Items:

1. Google your first and last name. Are you on the internet? Is there someone else with the same name?
2. Find your address on a map site or Google Earth. Is there a street view of your house?
3. Find the website for your school. What is the school's postcode/zipcode?
4. Look up the name of your favourite character from a book. Can you find out one thing you didn't know about them?
5. Think of an activity you'd like to do when quarantine ends. Look it up.
6. Is there something you'd really like to buy: a toy, book or gadget for example? See how much it costs online.
7. Find two things that happened in the world on the day you were born.
8. Find a picture of a place you'd like to visit someday.
9. What is your favourite homemade snack? Find a recipe for it online.
